# Vancouver Mini Club

## Meetings and Membership Regulations and guidelines

1. General meetings are always held on the third Wednesday of each month. The current venue is the Cottage Bistro at 4468 Main Street, Van. B.C., meeting starts at 8 pm with an optional dinner at 7pm. (This location changes seasonally)
2. All new members will pay a membership fee. (see below)
3. Types of Memberships:
  - A) Active Member: A member who participates in club events and monthly meetings.
  - B) Associate Member: The 2nd and all subsequent members of the family.
  - C) Member at Large: A member who lives out of normal driving range of Vancouver.
4. Registration Fees:

a) Active Member:	\$35.00
b) Associate Member:	\$20.00
c) Member at Large:	\$20.00
5. Subsequent Annual Fees:

a) Active Member:	\$30.00
b) Associate Member:	\$15.00
c) Member at Large:	\$15.00
6. The fiscal year for the club commences in June, therefore all fees are payable in June by the 30th day of that month. Annual fees received after the June 30th deadline will be assessed an additional \$5.00 re-registration fee.
7. A new member shall be entitled to the following upon joining the club:
  - 2 decals
  - 1 crest
  - a tentative schedule of annual events
  - a monthly newsletter
  - a club membership card
8. Any action that is detrimental to the club's reputation and safety is reason for immediate expulsion from the club.
